PRIVATE FOSTERING THE FACTS

A PRIVATELY FOSTERED CHILD IS ONE WHO:

- Is under 16 (or under 18 if disabled).
- Is provided with care and accommodation by someone who:
 - Is not a parent
 - Does not have parental responsibility
 - Is not a close relative*
- Is (or plans to be) provided with this accommodation continually for 28 days or more.

*close relatives are defined by the Children Act as parents, step-parents, grandparents, siblings, aunts or uncles.

WHAT I NEED TO DO:

 Call the Referral and Assessment Team on 01724 296500 to discuss the situation with a social worker.

• If in doubt call and discuss the situation with a social worker.

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT:

 Assessments will be undertaken to ensure the arrangements are appropriate.

REMEMBER

It is an OFFENCE for families not to notify the local council of a private fostering arrangement.
